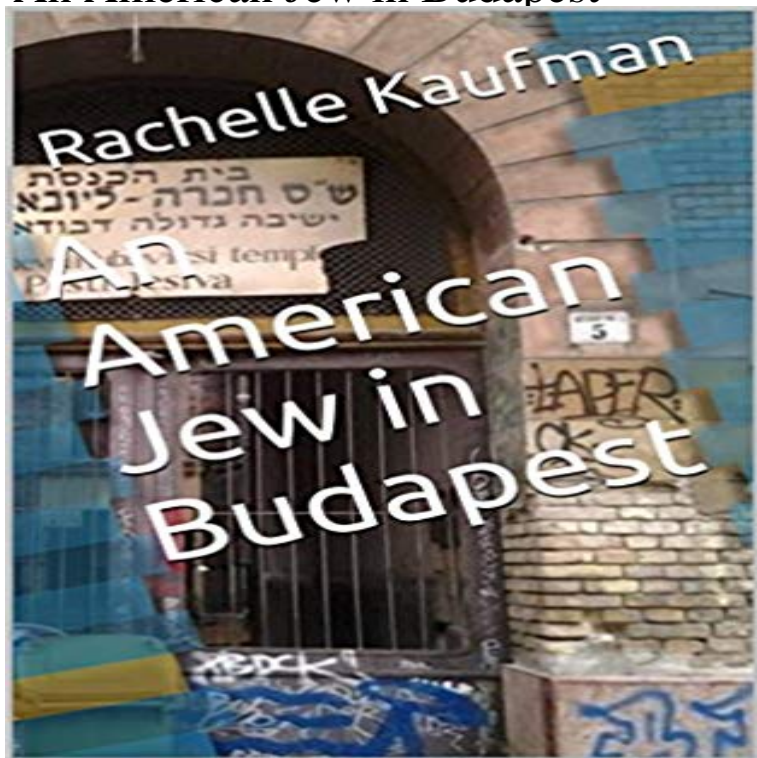


## An American Jew in Budapest
